

**SCORE CARD

BIG ROCK PLOWING MATCH ASSOCIATION**

Low back furrows distinct (back to be slightly crowning and all trash covered.....25 points  
 Furrows of uniform depth and width, showing slight ridge and distinct from end to end...25points  
 Line of furrow.....25 points  
 Covering of trash.....15 points  
 General neatness of the whole and the appearance of ends.....10points

**Total 100 points (perfect score)**

All plowman using 16 inch plows must plow not less than 14 inches.  
 All plowman using 14 inch plows must plow not less than 12 inches.  
 All plowman using 12 inch plows must plow not less than 10 inches.  
 All plowmen will be scored back for not finishing the lands by the specified finish time-4 points for each foot in width, and 4 points for each inch less than the minimum depth of 5 inches or for each inch in excess of the maximum depth of 7 inches.  
 All plowmen must plow 5 inches, but not more than 7 inches deep.  
 All plowmen w/12 inch plows must make 7 rounds, plowmen w/14 inch plows make 6 rounds.  
**NO ASSISTANCE** shall be given to any plowman after the first round is completed. This shall include, but not be limited to:

- \*Giving verbal instruction, making hand signals or otherwise, in regard to plow or hitch settings when the plowman is at either headland.
- \*Walking across the plowman's land to give verbal assistance while plow is in furrow.
- \*Giving guidance or spotting, either physically or with any markers, in regard to where a plowman should aim his front furrow wheel so as to stay square with plow upon leaving furrow on ends.

\*Any instruction given with the aid of wireless transmitter to plowman  
 Exception to this will be a major tractor breakdown to any plowman, or a major machinery malfunction involving a plowman **12 years of age or under**.  
**First Violation** recorded will be subject to a warning and a 6 point deduction from land scores.  
**Second Violation** will be subject to automatic disqualification.
